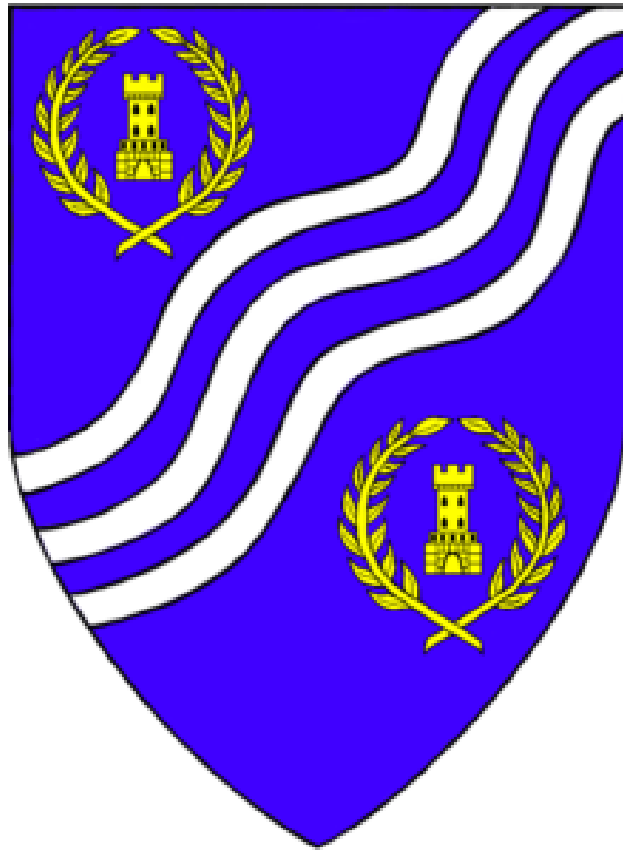

Gate: Friday: 5-Midnight, Saturday: 8am-2pm

Pets – Pets are allowed but must be picked up after. PETS IN CABIN BY PRIOR APPROVAL ONLY

Fires – Above ground fires only please, a fire extinguisher is required for all fires.

Parking – will be tight. Main parking is up front near the entrance sign to the group use site, across the road from the archery area.

Showers - Two showers are available in every cabin, for a total of 14 showers.

Smoking – Private camp, away from group, or consenting group. Please ensure no trash is left behind.

Offsite – Please be offsite by noon on Sunday.

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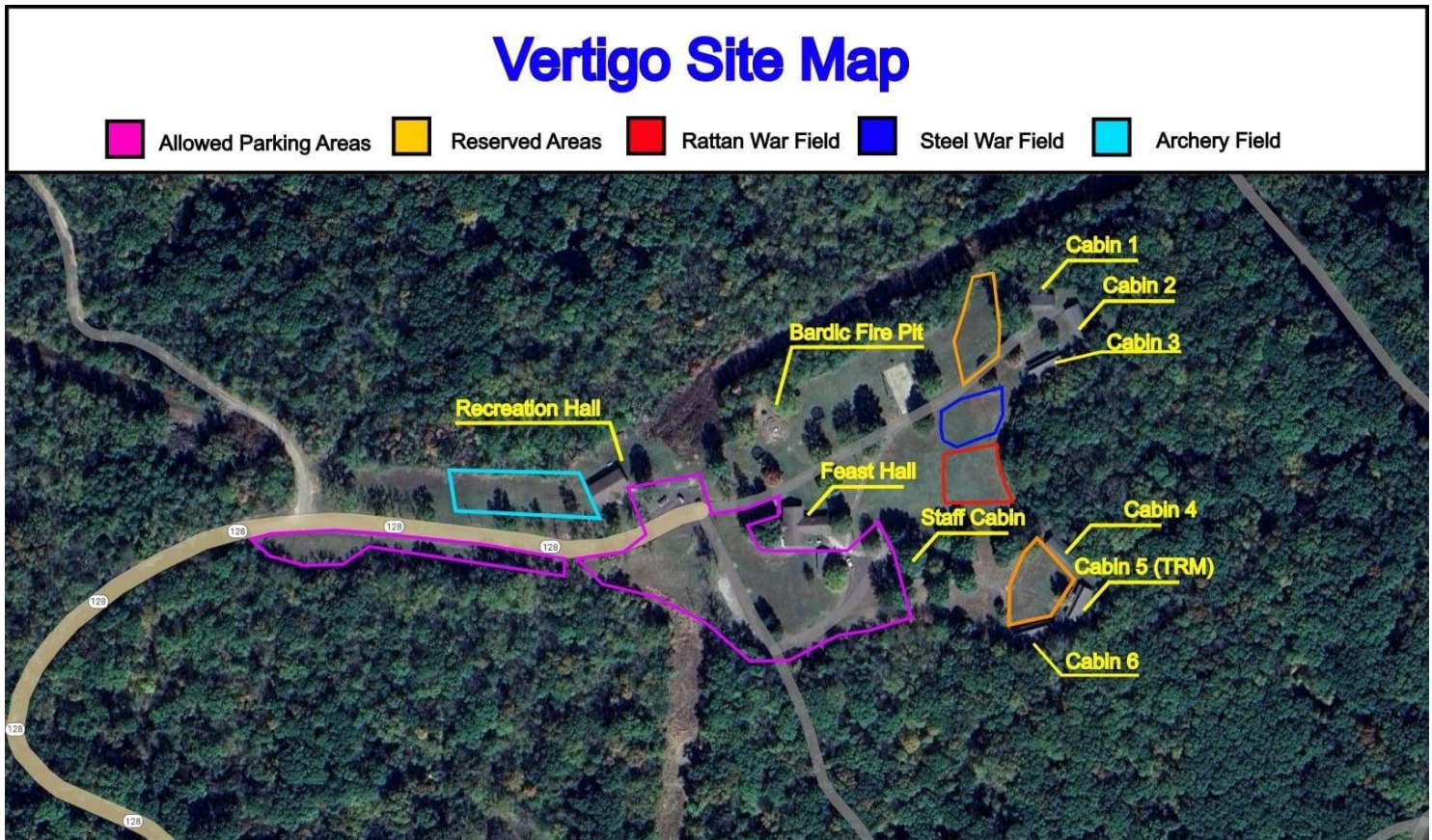
